Players get 1 roll to England attempt a successful show run. Players get 2 rolls to attempt a successful Take Five! show run. Italy Take Five! Teatro Farnese at Parma You're East! Spain Players get 3 rolls to attempt a successful show run. Pick A Corral de Comedias Youre East! Navigate the countries to be the first to have a successful show run, by rolling doubles, at each theatre. Collect role cards to use during each show attempt. Watch out for obstacles on the way! Normal Game: 1 die Fast Play: 2 dice

From Aristophanes' Lysistrata written in 411 B.C.E. She was the first female titular character and the first female main character in a Roman play.

If played, lose 1 roll, but if performance succeeds, add one space to every turn for the rest of the game.



From Lope de Vega's Fuenteovejuna, written in 1619. She drives the plot by leading her town to rebel against the town's toxic commander.

If played at the Corral de Comedias, add 1 roll.









In 1599, the Spanish Royal Council declared that women could perform ONLY if their husbands or fathers were in the company and if neither sex would appear in the dress of the other.

Go back two spaces.



In 1642, English Puritans passed a law that halted all theatre for 5 years. Actors had to perform in secret in order for theatre to still exist!
